RULES: IDPA Rules

COURSE DESIGNER: Joe Kirklin - North Valley Shooters Association - Gridley, CA

START POSITION:

Standing at P1 facing downrange, toes touching tire, barbecue tongs and beverage in hands.

SCENARIO:

You are enjoying a picnic with your family when an armed gangbanger threatens your life while his gang members assault your spouse and try to carry off your daughter as your son looks on. They picked the wrong victims.

PROCEDURE:

At the start signal, drop the tongs and beverage, draw, and while moving to P2 engage T1 - T3 with two rounds each in tactical priority. Targets may be re-engaged from cover at P2.

Proceed to P3. From cover at P3, engage Popper S-1. Steel must fall before proceeding. Engage remaining targets T4-T6 from cover at P3 with two rounds each in tactical priority.

SCORING: Unlimited

ROUND COUNT: 13

TARGETS: 07

DISTANCE: 1-15 yards

SCORED HITS: Best two hits per target, steel must fall.

PENALTIES:

CONCEALMENT: Yes

NOTES: S1 triggers mover. T5 is a disappearing target. Moving target causes P3 cover line to move accordingly.
