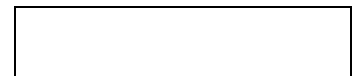
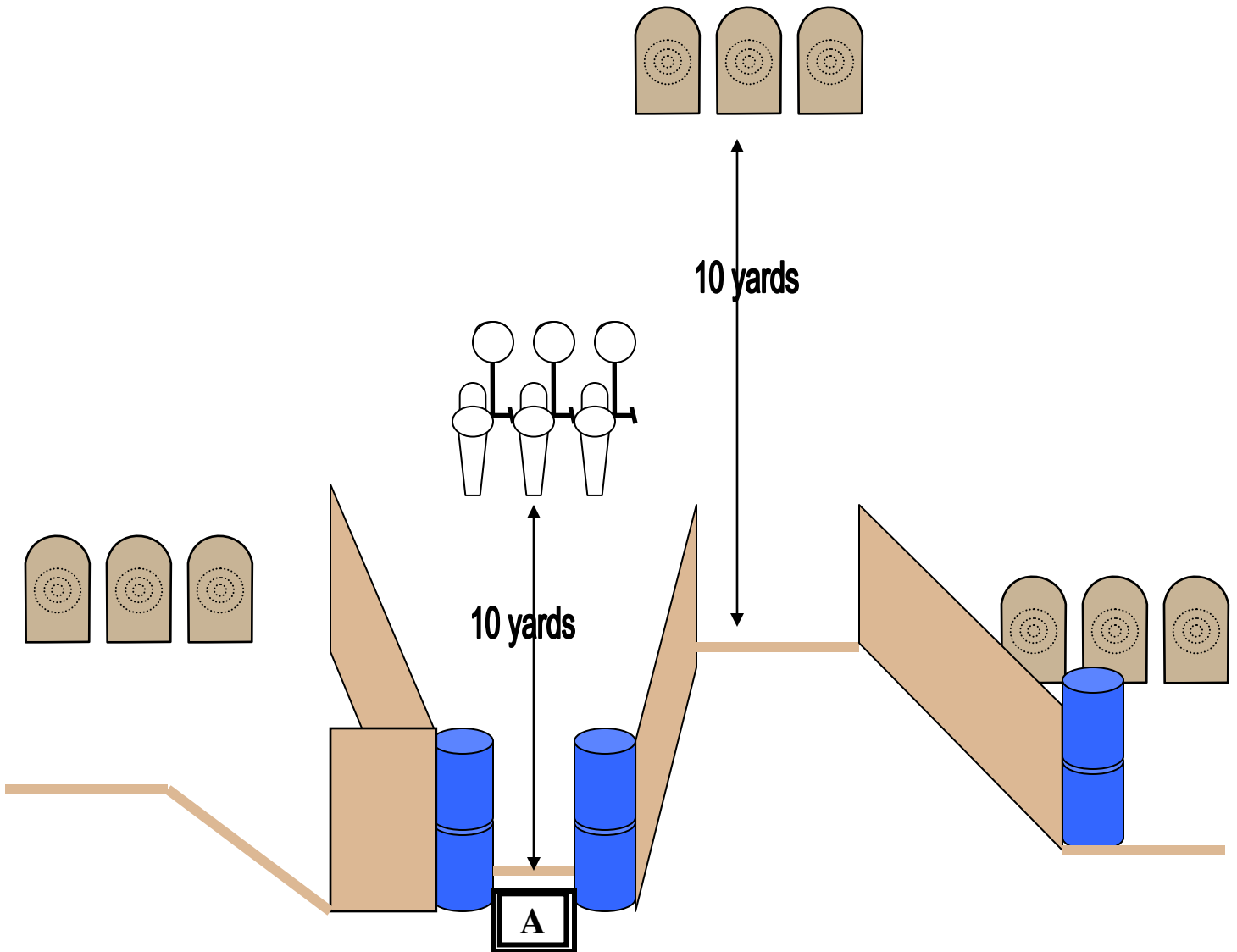


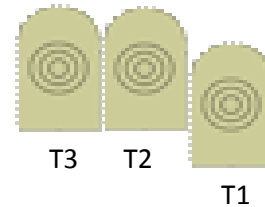
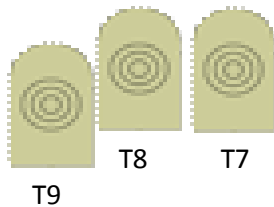
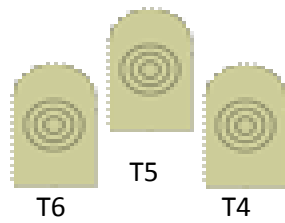
Which Way Do I Go?

Shooter will start in Box A facing downrange, hands above shoulders. At the signal, draw and engage Steel from Box A ONLY. Then engage all other targets with 2-rds each in any order from the shooting area.

- NOTES:**
- Shots Unlimited - 24 minimum
 - (9) NRA D-1 paper / (3) Pepper Poppers / (3) Plates
 - Penalties per ICORE rulebook
 - Range of engagement: approx 1 to 15-yards

SCORING - Shots Limited
ROUNDS - 18 Maximum
Standard ICORE Scoring
TARGETS – 9 NRA D-1

Start Position = Any Box, Loaded Gun in Holster,
– Hands above Shoulders.

START – Audible
STOP - Last Shot

{Width and distance to fit the Bay}

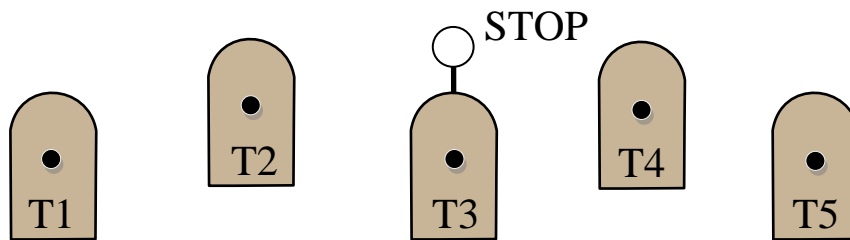
STAGE PROCEDURE...

From Box A; Engage **ONLY T1 through T3** With 2 Shots each
From Box B; Engage **ONLY T4 through T6** With 2 Shots each
From Box C; Engage **ONLY T7 through T9** With 2 Shots each
MANDATORY RELOAD BETWEEN BOXES

STAGE 3: CHOICES

PROCEDURE: Shooter starts in the 'FREE shooting area, revolver unloaded in holster, facing up range. At the signal, from any box, the shooter engages T1 – T5 with one shot each in any order, performs a mandatory reload, engages T1 – T5 with one shot, performs a mandatory reload, engages T1 – T5 with one shot each and after a final mandatory reload, the timer stops when 'STOP' steel falls.

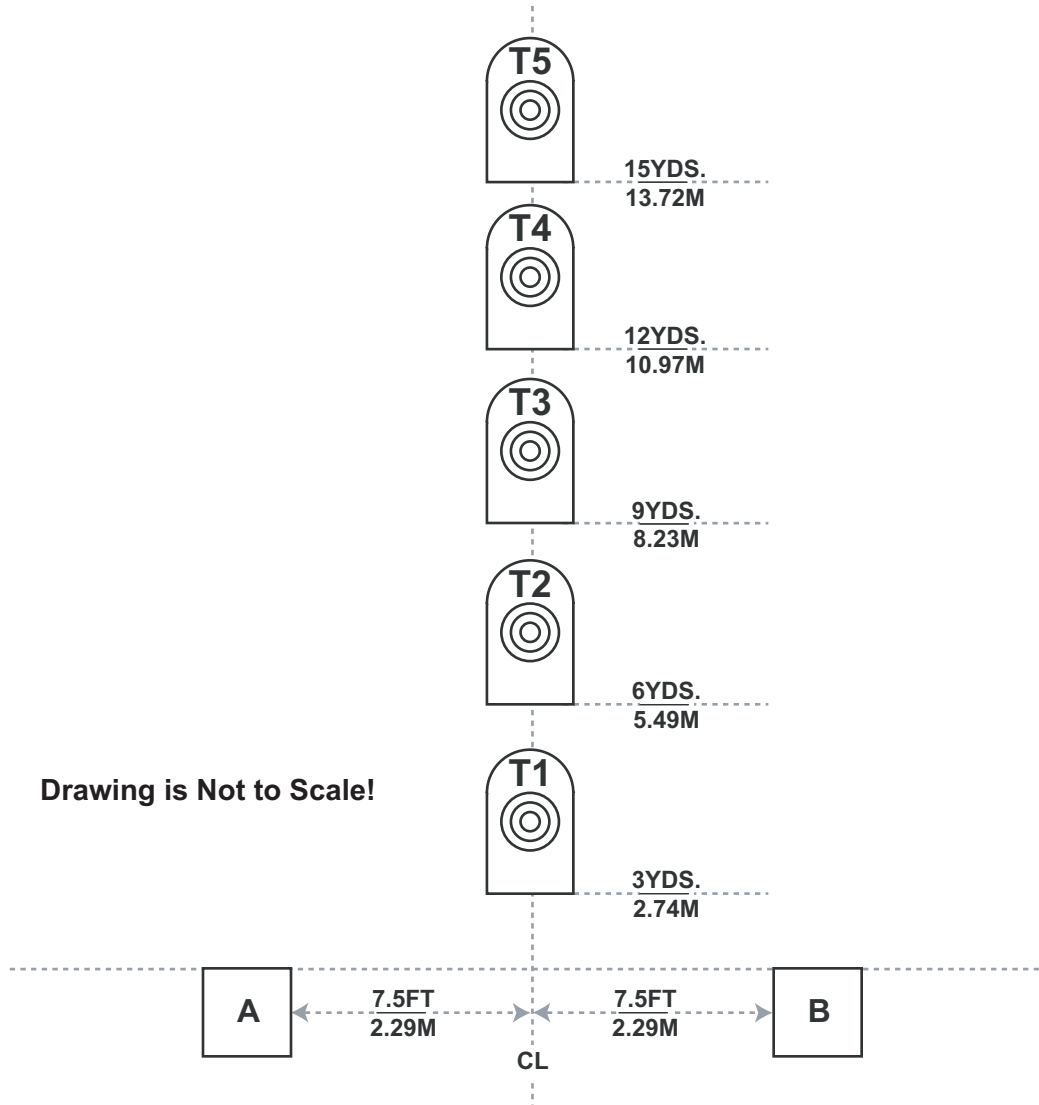
NOTES:

- Drawing not to scale; range from 'FREE' to 'STOP' is approx. 26 yards; 'STRONG' to T5 is about 16 yards; 'WEAK' to T2 is approx. 7 yards.
- All shots must be made from the Shooting areas.
- Shots from box 'FREE' may be made using any style, including prone.
- Shots from 'STRONG' shooting area must be made strong hand only.
- Shots from 'WEAK' shooting area must use weak hand only.
- Shots on paper limited - 15 shots maximum ('STOP' plate engaged until it falls).
- Shots hitting black X ring score one second bonus.



Line Up and Take Sides

Start Position: Standing in either Box A or Box B, facing downrange, hands relaxed at sides.

Procedure:

At the signal, from the start Box engage T1 thru T5 with only two (2) rounds each in any order. While moving to the opposite box, make a mandatory reload. From the opposite Box engage T1 thru T5 with only two (2) rounds each in any order. One Continuous string.

Scoring: Shots Limited

Targets: 5 NRA D-1 paper

Rounds: 20

Start: Audible

Stop: Last shot

Penalties: Per the ICORE rulebook. Foot faults, extra shots, extra hits, procedurals and misses +5 seconds per occurrence.

Stage Setup: Place targets per drawing dimensions. Set targets T1 thru T5 at standard height with top of target 1.65 m (5 feet 6 inch) +/- 5cm (2 inches) from ground. Alignment is shown to centerlines of boxes and targets, unless otherwise noted.

Shooting boxes are approximately 1m x 1m (3 feet x 3 feet).
